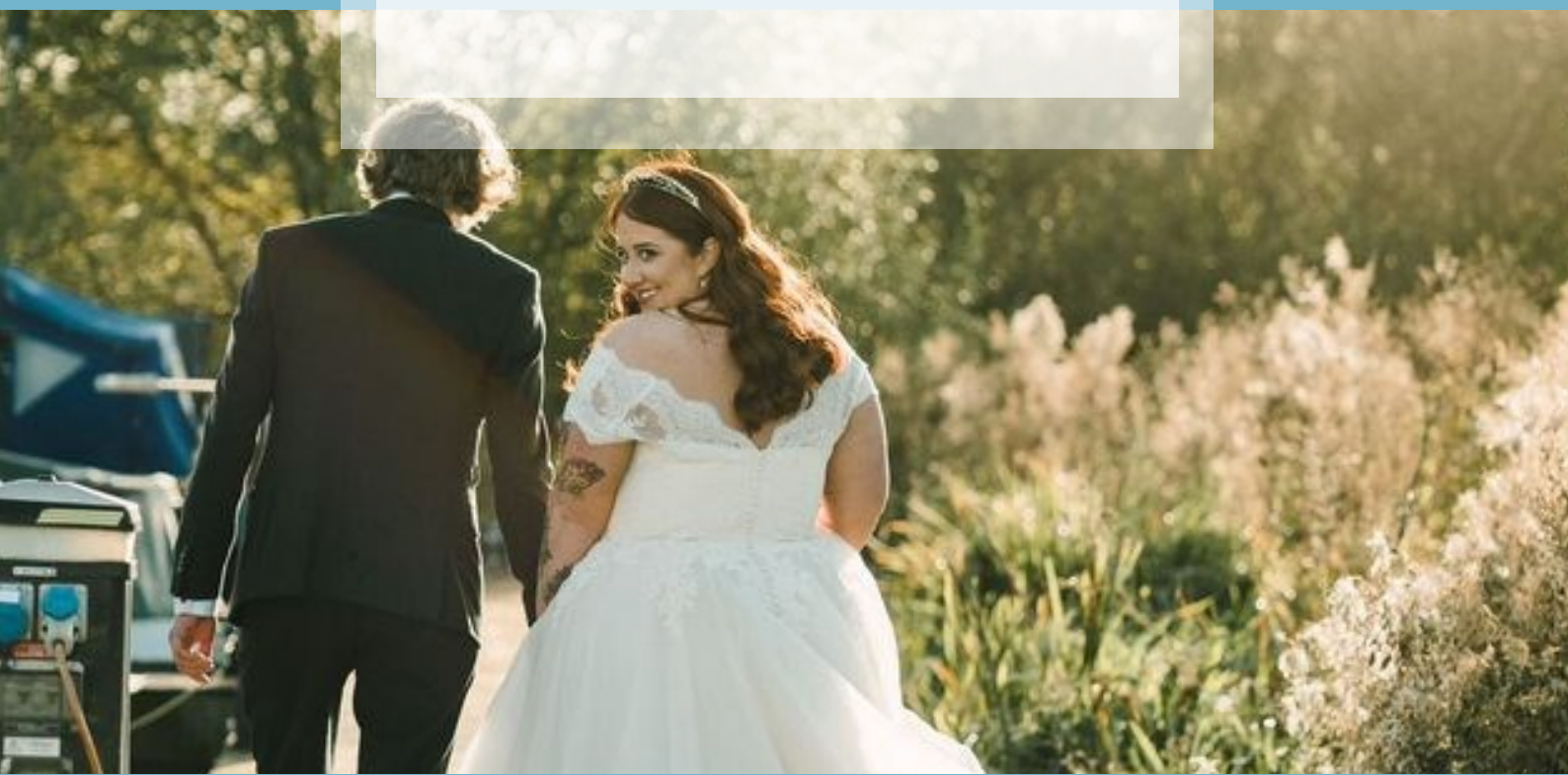

Blossom and Tied - Laura really helped us bring our visions together and she pulled it off amazingly.

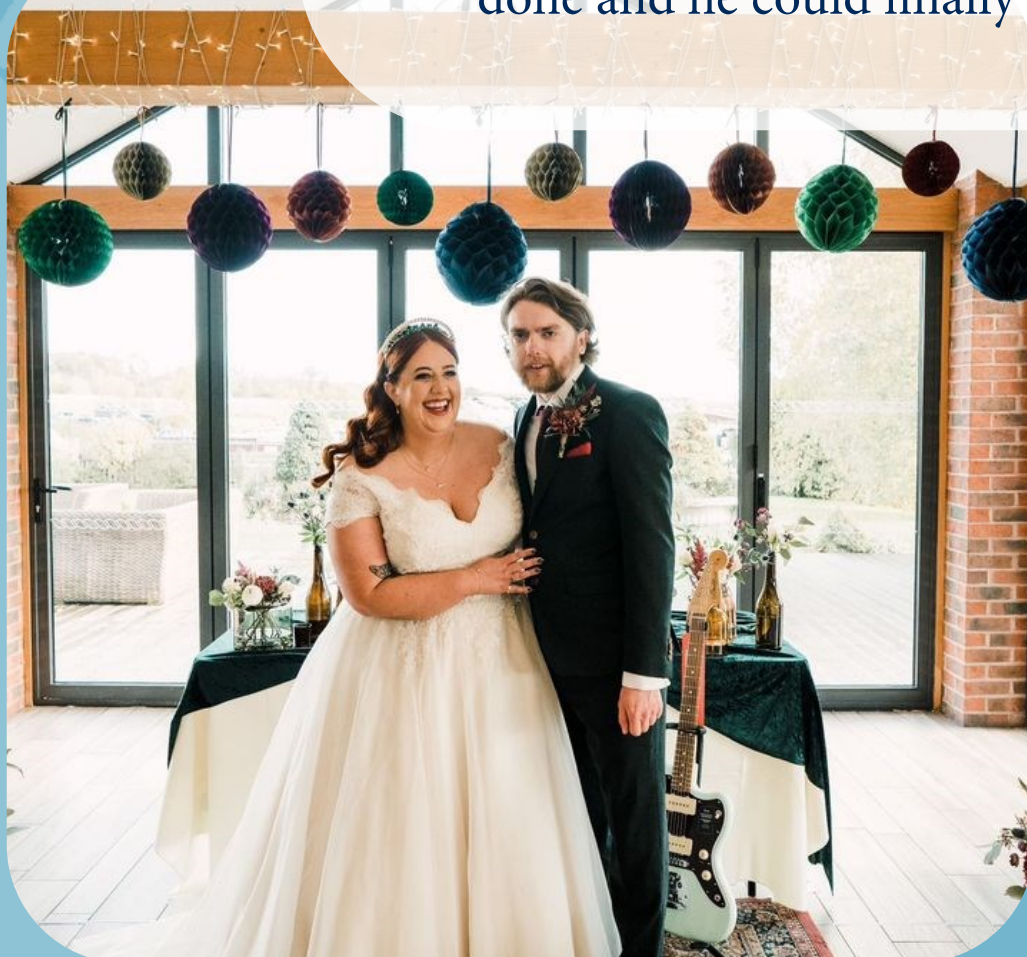
Alice Charlesworth MUA - Such a laugh and made me so relaxed getting ready.
